GRAMMAR CLASSES

Our grammar course focuses on building basic and intermediate grammar, vocabulary, writing, and conversation skills. Active interaction with Americans is an essential part of this class and American students will be assigned to your students as tutors and mentors during class and field trip excursions. The field trips are designed to acquaint students with life in the United States. We will explore our traditions and way of life and compare them to traditions and life in their country. Some of the topics we will study are American Holidays, American manners and etiquette, politics, news, sports, music, art, and movies that depict American life.

Classes: Monday through Friday
Weekends and evenings spent in host family activities.

FIELD TRIPS

Field trip options may include: Multnomah Falls, Crown Point, the state capital in Salem, the Bonneville Dam and Fish Hatchery, North Clackamas Aquatics Center, Fort Vancouver National Historic Site, a fire station tour, Woodburn Outlet Mall, Oregon Humane Society, Portland Aerial Tram, OHSU Primate Lab, arcade, movie, restaurant etiquette, golfing and bowling, Pendleton Woolen Mills and OMSI.

Field trip options may also include: Mt. St. Helens Johnston Ridge Observatory, Silver Falls, Columbia River Maritime Museum and Astoria Column.

This program is designed to not only teach English, but allow the students to actively practice their conversations skills with American high school students and host families throughout their visit.
